A SEPTA is a district-wide **S**pecial **E**ducation **P**arent **T**eacher **A**ssociation and is part of New York State PTA and National PTA. "SEPTA" was designed to build strong partnerships among parents, teachers, administrators, existing PTA's and the community, for the benefit of families and children receiving special education services.

Who are SEPTA members?
