Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope this correspondence finds you and your family healthy. In light of these unprecedented times related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Connetquot Central School District has formulated an instructional continuity plan for remote learning.

The District is in receipt of evolving information from the Suffolk County Department of Health and the New York State Education Department. We understand that this situation is stressful for you and the District's students, and trust that our approach to instructional continuity will provide structure and maintain student learning. We look forward to continuing our partnership with you in this academic endeavor.

The steps we have taken thus far are as follows:

- Your child's teachers will be contacting you via email on or before Thursday March 26, 2020 with preliminary information regarding the platform(s) that will be utilized for instructional delivery.
- As scheduled, Trimester 2 ended on Friday March 20, 2020. Trimester 2 report cards will reflect students' efforts up to and including March 13, 2020.
- Beginning on March 26, 2020, until the District reopens, virtual assignments for Trimester 3 will be assessed as Pass/Fail.

To our special education parents, any Committee on Special Education meeting (CSE meeting) scheduled on or before April 13, 2020 is cancelled. The Special Education Department will be reaching out to all families by phone and/or email to confirm meetings and/or reschedule meetings.

The New York State Education Department has suspended all elementary- and intermediate-level State assessments for the remainder of this school year.

The district will continue to provide you with updates as we gain a better understanding of how long the COVID-19 pandemic will impact our schools. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this challenging time. We are up for the challenge and look forward to furthering your child's education moving forward.
