Dear Parents and Students,

We hope that you and your family are doing well during these difficult times. The Elementary Engineering Team (Mr. Brennan, Mrs. Ferraro, Mr. Llanes and Mrs. Mongiello) have been working together to plan for the coming weeks of distance learning. This will be a fun and new experience for many of us. There may be bumps in the road but we will try our best to help each other navigate through it.

We will be using Google Classroom to post weekly assignments. The students will use their district user name and password to access these assignments. Each student has a district username, making it easy for them to contact us directly with questions through google classroom (or through the parent's email). We believe that the students will be able to do this independently once they see how to access their engineering links.

To begin, the students should go on the internet to classrooms.google.com

Note: If you already know how to access google classroom through CLEVER on the district website, feel free to use that path instead.

For Grades K to 2 only TO LOG IN TO GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Step 1: To login to Google use your school email (this is only just a user name and not an actual email account).

SCHOOL EMAIL: first name, middle initial, last name, @ ccsdli.org
ex. samtsmith@ccsdli.org

PASSWORD FOR STUDENTS: Use the password provided by your classroom teacher that you use to log on to the computer at school.

Note: Using this username and password is new for K – 2 students, so if you are having password problems (and your classroom teacher does not have the new passwords for you, contact tech support at techsupport@ccsdli.org)

Step 2: Click on the “+” sign in the top right hand corner to add a class.

Step 3: For grades K to 2 choose “Join Class”

Step 4: Enter the code **4jemvsy**

Step 5: You will see the Engineering Classroom for grades K to 2. Click on the Engineering K to 2 logo and read the stream of comments from your engineering teacher. Then select **Classwork** at the top of the screen to get to the assignments for the week.

For Grades 3 to 5 only TO LOG IN TO GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Note: Some of you may already have a google classroom account for CS & E (recently renamed Engineering). If so, skip steps 2, 3 and 4.

Step 1: To login to Google use your school email (this is only just a user name and not an actual email account).

SCHOOL EMAIL: first name, middle initial, last name, @ ccsdli.org

ex. samtsmith@ccsdli.org

PASSWORD FOR STUDENTS: Use the password provided by your classroom teacher that you use to log on to the computer at school.

Step 2: Click on the “+” sign in the top right hand corner to add a class.

Step 3: For grades 3 to 5 choose “Join Class”

Step 4: Enter the code **pimyrzc**

Step 5: You will see the Engineering Classroom for grades 3 to 5. Click on the Engineering 3rd to 5th logo and read the stream of comments from your engineering teachers. Then select **Classwork** at the top of the screen to get to the assignments for the week.

You will now be in google classroom. There is a video link at the bottom of this email for students that will help explain the way Google Classroom works called, "Google Classroom Tutorial and Student Guide". The first day for students school work is Thursday, March 26. We wanted to give you time to login and try to familiarize yourself with Google Classroom.
